Tipps for application

Walls can be treated in various ways with AURO products from the Walls and Ceilings range. Possibilities start with the usual painting or plastering and extend to individual techniques for creative wall design. The natural raw materials in our products make it easy to go green: Wood treated with Auro products, as well as residues of the products, can be composted in dried state without any harm to the environment. They just return into nature's cycle of materials.

The following pages show an overview of the products and their fields of application. Please consider that nature, structure and absorbency of the substrate can influence the actual coating, as can substances contained in the substrate. Before large-scale application of the products we therefore recommend a pretest on a small spot to see if the desired result is achieved. The single application steps and the respective products are not obligatory but dependent on the given on-site situation.

Please buy products with the same batch numbers. Colour tones can vary slightly from one batch to another because natural raw materials are used in the products.

COLOURS FOR LIFE: Premium wall and ceiling paint (555) and High-grade Clay paint (535) for indoor use are available on demand in more than 700 machine-mixed colour tones.

Tinting: Colouring of an emulsion or lime wall paint by addition of pigmented paint concentrates. The intensity of the colour tone is defined by the mixing ratio.

A choice of mixtures of Wall paint No. 321 with Tinting colours No. 330 and of AURO High-grade lime paint No. 344 with Lime tinting base No. 350 can also be found in the abovementioned colour tone fan (art. 00204).

Full-shade: Pure pigment concentrate Nos. 330 or 350. Painted pure, they produce very intensive colour tones.

Glazing: On a white surface, one or more coats of Colour wash plant glaze no. 360 are applied. The colours of the first layer(s) shine through the following ones and produce a very lively appearance.

Waxing: A clear or coloured layer of the translucent Wall glaze wax no. 370 is applied with cloth or brush and polished. This application provides additional protection from mechanical strain, e.g. around light switches, in children's rooms or in corridors.
